A PROCLAMATION

AMERICAN PHARMACISTS MONTH

WHEREAS:	Pharmacists – who are some of the most accessible healthcare providers – are responsible for caring for the overall well-being of Georgians across the state; and
WHEREAS:	Pharmacists have proved their importance in providing patient care by becoming healthcare access points for patients across both rural and urban areas in Georgia; and
WHEREAS:	Pharmacists ensure proper medication therapy, improve health outcomes, provide access to necessary vaccinations, and establish patient adherence to medications; and
WHEREAS:	The American Pharmacists Association supports October as American Pharmacists Month as an opportunity to appreciate and provide recognition for pharmacists' commitment to serving patients over the entire state; and
WHEREAS:	The State of Georgia celebrates the work done by the men and women in pharmacies across the state, and encourages all Georgia citizens to acknowledge the importance of their local pharmacists; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim October 2024, as AMERICAN PHARMACISTS MONTH in Georgia.
