## **A PROCLAMATION**

## AMNIOTIC FLUID EMBOLISM AWARENESS DAY

WHEREAS:	Amniotic fluid embolism (AFE) is a catastrophic complication of pregnancy in which amniotic fluid, fetal cells, hair, or other debris enters the maternal pulmonary circulation, causing cardiovascular collapse; and
WHEREAS:	Amniotic fluid embolism (AFE) is a leading cause of maternal mortality, and yet can be very difficult to diagnose because the symptoms are often like other serious complications during childbirth; and
WHEREAS:	An AFE is thought to be the result of an allergic-like reaction to the amniotic fluid or fetal cells that have entered the circulatory system during childbirth, a normal part of the birth process; and
WHEREAS:	AFE Foundation, working in collaboration with key stakeholders in GA, provides meaningful and education and life-saving skills to properly prepare healthcare providers to manage and treat patients; increase lives saved; gain submissions to the AFE Registry and Biorepository; and
WHEREAS:	Awareness of AFE and commensurate data collection and research will promote - understanding of this disorder; expanding the search for an effective treatment; acceleration the increased number of lives saved; now
