more than 5 million individuals in the U.S. The construction industry needs 1.9

million new craft professionals by 2025; and

WHEREAS: NCCER was created by the construction industry to standardize training and

enhance the industry image by promoting the hard work and dedication of craft professionals. Careers in Construction Month honors construction craft professionals and the critical role they play in the development and growth of

our state of Georgia; and

WHEREAS: Collaborative organizations, such as Construction Ready, Georgia Department
