WHEREAS: Community corrections is an essential part of the justice system in the State of Georgia;

and

WHEREAS: Community corrections professionals are trained to provide services and referrals for

individuals and are also responsible for supervising adult and juvenile individuals in

the community; and

WHEREAS: In addition to working with these individuals, community corrections professionals

also work in partnership with community agencies and groups, as well as providing services, support, and protection for victims. In doing so, they promote prevention,

intervention, and advocacy; and

WHEREAS: Community corrections professionals uphold the law with dignity, while recognizing

the right of the public to be safe guarded from criminal activity; and

WHEREAS: The Georgia Department of Community Supervision is nationally recognized for their

contributions to the community corrections profession which reflect positively on our

State; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim July 21-

27, 2024, as COMMUNITY SUPERVISION WEEK in Georgia.
