WHEREAS: As preventive specialists, dental hygienists contribute to the oral health of patients and

provide an essential service to benefit citizens' overall well-being; and

WHEREAS: Regular preventive checkups and cleanings, brushing and flossing, eating a well-

balanced diet, and monitoring gums for signs of gum disease are basic steps to ensuring

good oral hygiene and care; and

WHEREAS: Dental Hygienists give their time and talent to provide oral health care services to

individuals in need, including children, senior citizens, individuals with disabilities, and

those in underserved communities; and

WHEREAS: These services are vital in dental offices, public health facilities, schools, long-term care

settings, hospitals, private organizations, and research facilities for providing the best

possible health care for all citizens; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim February

8, 2024, as DENTAL HYGIENISTS' DAY in Georgia.
