### GEORGIA CUP DAY

- WHEREAS:** Mr. Nick Dunlap of Huntsville, Alabama, and the University of Alabama, while displaying great golfing skill, courage, and sportsmanship, won the United States Amateur Championship in 2023; and
- WHEREAS:** Mr. Christo Lamprecht of South Africa and the Georgia Institute of Technology, while displaying great golf skill, courage, and sportsmanship, won the British Amateur Championship in 2023; and
- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia enjoys a long and illustrious history of distinguished golf champions, both professional and amateur; and
- WHEREAS:** The Golf Club of Georgia has organized a competition between the United States and British Amateur Golf Champions known as The Georgia Cup; and
- WHEREAS:** The Georgia Cup provides a unique golf competition and is a charitable fundraising event benefiting Folds of Honor; and
- WHEREAS:** The Georgia Cup is a celebration of championship amateur golf and the honor, integrity, sportsmanship, and civility displayed by those competitors who have played with such distinction; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim April 7, 2024, as GEORGIA CUP DAY in Georgia.
