## **A PROCLAMATION**

## **GEORGIA STEM DAY**

WHEREAS:	Georgia STEM Day is a statewide opportunity for schools, students, teachers, and companies to raise awareness by celebrating and engaging in innovative, hands-on activities involving Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics; and
WHEREAS:	Georgia STEM Day helps students make the critical connection between the classroom and future career opportunities; and
WHEREAS:	Innovative and quality STEM education is vital for students' academic and professional success, and STEM skills are essential to Georgia's future workforce and economy; and
WHEREAS:	Organizations like the Technology Association of Georgia (TAG) help to provide resources and support for Georgia's STEM and technology community. By driving innovation and inspiring tech leaders and educators alike to promote the importance of STEM, Georgia's students are benefiting from well rounded, career-oriented learning opportunities; and
WHEREAS:	On March 1, 2024, the State of Georgia encourages its citizens to engage in STEM activities and to empower Georgia's students to learn about potential career pathways to help usher in a new era of STEM leaders in Georgia and beyond; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim March 1, 2024, as GEORGIA STEM DAY in Georgia.
