GEORGIA TECHNOLOGY AND INNOVATION DAY

- WHEREAS: Georgia's technology industry and its culture of innovation are essential components in the continued financial growth of businesses across Georgia and global socioeconomic impact; and
- WHEREAS: The State of Georgia is committed to fostering the development and success of technology sectors and their ability to create, expand, and sustain industry-leading innovations that positively impact the economy and our quality of life; and
- WHEREAS: The Technology Association of Georgia (TAG) hosts the annual Georgia Technology Summit to create a forum for the best and brightest technology leaders to share their knowledge around emerging technologies that foster innovation and to recognize Georgia's top innovative companies; and

WHEREAS: The Summit event inducts new members into the Technology Hall of Fame and includes the issuance of an annual State of the Industry: Technology in Georgia report to highlight Georgia's technology strengths.
