WHEREAS: Thousands of brave Georgians serve in the military and have taken the oath to support

and defend the Constitution of the United States against all enemies, foreign and

domestic; and

WHEREAS: The children of these brave men and women make significant contributions to our

schools, communities, and the State of Georgia, despite prolonged and repeated

absences of one or both parents; and

WHEREAS: Georgia's military children are a source of pride and honor to us all, and it is fitting

that we take time to recognize their contributions, celebrate their spirit, and let our men and women in uniform know that, while they take care of us, we will take care of

their children; and

WHEREAS: The recognition of April as Month of the Military Child provides a special opportunity

to pay tribute to military children for their commitment, their sacrifice, and their

unconditional support of our troops; and

WHEREAS: Georgians are encouraged to observe this month by connecting with military children

and families to provide support to all Georgia children affected by the deployment of

parents and other caring adults in their lives; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim April

2024, as MONTH OF THE MILITARY CHILD in Georgia.
