A PROCLAMATION

PARENTS' DAY

WHEREAS:	In October 1994, resolved by the senate and the House of representatives of the United States of America in Congress Assembled, that 4th Sunday of every July shall be established as "Parents Day" to be recognized as recurring, perennial day of commemoration; and
WHEREAS:	As a child's first role models, parents shape the character of those who will help to build the future of our nation. On Parents' Day, we pay tribute to the hard work and sacrifices of the millions of devoted parents who provide unconditional love, education, guidance to their children; and
WHEREAS:	Healthy and God centered families are the foundation for healthy, well-adjusted nations, because the values that promote peace in the world communities are a direct extension of the values that promote peace within individual families; and
WHEREAS:	"Parents Day" was founded as an initiative of the universal Peace Federation, a global network of peace builders, and NGO of the United Nations. The co-founder of UPF is Dr Hak Ja Han Moon, globally known as the Mother of Peace for her crusades around the globe entitled "Peace Starts With Me"; and
WHEREAS:	Governmental programs, faith-based and local nonprofits, and community groups across this state provide resources to help parents as they work hard to raise children of good moral character, with skills to help them succeed in life; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim July 28, 2024, as PARENTS' DAY in Georgia.
