WHEREAS: The mothers and fathers who lose children to such painful circumstances are often in

need of support and encouragement, and an increase in available information about these tragedies can allow families to feel more supported throughout their grief; and

WHEREAS: A public that is educated about pregnancy and infant loss can better learn to respond

with compassion to such tragedies; and

WHEREAS: Professionals who help the families who have suffered pregnancy or infant loss, such

as physicians, clergy, emergency medical technicians, funeral directors, police officers, nurses, and employers can offer sympathy and care during their time of need; and

WHEREAS: Pregnancy and Infant Loss Awareness Month is a time to offer support to those

affected by the loss of a baby or child. The State of Georgia recognizes the grief of

these families as they seek comfort from this heartache; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim October

2024, as PREGNANCY AND INFANT LOSS AWARENSS MONTH in Georgia.
