A PROCLAMATION

PULMONARY REHABILITATION WEEK

WHEREAS:	Pulmonary disease is the third leading cause of death in the United States. Examples of Chronic lung disease include: Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD), including emphysema, chronic bronchitis, asthma, bronchiectasis, or cystic fibrosis; Interstitial lung diseases, including pulmonary fibrosis, sarcoidosis, and hypersensitivity pneumonitis; lung cancer; post lung volume reduction surgery; before and after lung transplantation; and pulmonary hypertension are examples of chronic lung conditions; and
WHEREAS:	Pulmonary rehabilitation is a supervised education and exercise program designed to help people with chronic lung diseases. Participants may notice fewer breathing problems, more strength, and an improved quality of life; and
WHEREAS:	Participants learn to exercise with less shortness of breath; give and receive peer support; and successfully adopt the skills and knowledge necessary to manage his or her condition; and
WHEREAS:	The American Association of Cardiovascular and Pulmonary Rehabilitation (AACVPR) observes National Pulmonary Rehabilitation Week on March 10-16, 2024. The theme for this year is, "Breathe Easy, Live Freely"; and
WHEREAS:	During Pulmonary Rehabilitation Week, the State of Georgia recognizes the dedicated professionals who work continuously to share information about pulmonary disease, its prevention, and rehabilitation; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim March 10-16, 2024, as PULMONARY REHABILITATION WEEK in Georgia.

In witness thereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of the Executive Department to be affixed this 11th day of March in the year of our Lord, Two Thousand and Twenty-Four.
