A PROCLAMATION

SENIOR WEEK

WHEREAS:	In 1977 the State of Georgia authorized the establishment of the Georgia Council on Aging to serve as trusted advisors to the State's leadership regarding areas of concern being faced by Georgia's elderly citizens; and
WHEREAS:	The Coalition of Advocates for Georgia's Elderly (COAGE) was established by the Council to provide a means through which members of the aging network could collaborate and identify the most pressing issues facing seniors all across our State; and
WHEREAS:	Georgia's 1.5 million citizens 65 and older represent 15.1 percent of the state's population and is the fastest growing segment of the population; and
WHEREAS:	These citizens provide invaluable resources and contributions to the overall position that Georgia holds as one of the best places to live; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim February 12-16, 2024, as SENIOR WEEK in Georgia.
