## A PROCLAMATION

### WINDOW FILM DAY

- WHEREAS:** Window Film when professionally installed on existing windows, upgrades window performance to current energy standards, aides in the reduction of energy use, and helps to reduce carbon emissions; and
- WHEREAS:** Window Film helps to screen out dangerous UV rays and may help to protect skin from cancer and eyes from glare and damaging diseases; and
- WHEREAS:** Window Film also provides job and business opportunities for people in their local communities; and
- WHEREAS:** By lowering energy costs, especially during seasonal changes and peak electricity demand, Window Film can positively impact citizens' lives by helping to make their utility costs more affordable; and
- WHEREAS:** On National Window Film Day, the State of Georgia recognizes the citizens who manufacture, distribute, and install Window Film and those who work to promote its benefits; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim April 30, 2024, as WINDOW FILM DAY in Georgia.
