fields, including elected and appointed public office, military service, education,

medicine, the arts, philanthropy, charitable services; and

WHEREAS: Women across the United States have contributed to the great achievements and

prosperity of our country, and their strength, resilience and courage should be honored

and recognized; and

WHEREAS: In 1980 President Jimmy Carter issued a proclamation declaring the week of March

8th as National Women's History Week. Six years after his proclamation Congress

declared March of each year as Women's History Month; and

WHEREAS: All Georgians are encouraged to recognize the women who have left their mark on

the history of our state and nation, as well as those whose leadership will continue to

ensure our best days lie ahead; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim March

2024, as WOMENS HISTORY MONTH in Georgia.
