A PROCLAMATION

YOUTH ENTREPRENEURSHIP DAY

WHEREAS:	Research shows that businesses are increasingly seeking individuals who possess the entrepreneurial mindset, including skills in critical thinking and problem solving, flexibility and adaptability, communications and collaboration, comfort with risk, initiative and self-reliance, opportunity recognition, creativity and innovation and the ability to look toward their futures and plan and achieve long-term goals; and
WHEREAS:	Entrepreneurship education is proven to promote achievement and fuel a future of a new generation of diverse entrepreneurs and business leaders into the United States business market; and
WHEREAS:	On Youth Entrepreneurship Day, the State of Georgia recognizes all the young Georgians who are exploring entrepreneurship and commends the hardworking educators who are inspiring young minds to enter the field; now
THEREFORE:	I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim NOVEMBER 15, 2024, as YOUTH ENTREPRENEUSHIP DAY in Georgia.
