

House Bill 1427 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to provide for the Board of Education of Dooly County, approved
2 April 6, 1967 (Ga. L. 1967, p. 2922), as amended, particularly by an Act approved May 6,
3 2013 (Ga. L. 2013, p. 4149), so as to provide for compensation of the members of the board;
4 to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
5 other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act to provide for the Board of Education of Dooly County, approved April 6, 1967
9 (Ga. L. 1967, p. 2922), as amended, particularly by an Act approved May 6, 2013 (Ga. L.
10 2013, p. 4149), is amended by revising Section 6A to read as follows:

11 "SECTION 6A.

12 Members of the Dooly County Board of Education shall receive pay up to \$200.00 per
13 month for each month or portion of a month during which they serve on the Board of
14 Education. In addition, the members of the board shall be reimbursed for actual expenses
15 necessarily incurred in connection with attendance at meetings of the board and while

16 traveling within or outside the state as a member of the board on official business first
17 authorized by a majority of the members of the board. The accounts for such expenses
18 shall be submitted for approval to the county school superintendent. The compensation of
19 members of the board shall be paid only from the local tax funds available to the board for
20 education purposes, and shall be paid only if the board appropriates money to pay the
21 members such salaries. In the event that the board does not appropriate money to pay such
22 salaries, the board members shall be paid whatever lesser amount is approved and
23 appropriated by majority vote of the board."

24 **SECTION 2.**

25 This Act shall become effective on the first day of the month following the month in which
26 it is approved by the Governor or in which it becomes law without such approval.

27 **SECTION 3.**

28 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
