A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 36 of Chapter 1 of Title 10 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to online marketplace requirements, so as to revise certain definitions; to provide for
- 3 related matters; to provide for a short title; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

6 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Combating Organized Retail Crime Act."

7 SECTION 2.

- 8 Article 36 of Chapter 1 of Title 10 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 online marketplace requirements, is amended by revising paragraphs (2), (4), and (5) of Code
- 10 Section 10-1-940, relating to definitions, as follows:
- 11 "(2) 'High-volume third-party seller' means a participant in an online marketplace that
- is a third-party seller and that, in any continuous 12 month period during the previous
- 13 24 months, has entered into 200 or more discrete sales or transactions of new or unused
- 14 consumer products of an aggregate total of \$5,000.00 or more in gross revenues in this

15 state made through by utilizing the online marketplace and for which payment was 16 processed by the online marketplace or through a third party." 17 "(4) 'Seller' means a person who sells, offers to sell, or contracts to sell a consumer 18 product through utilizing an online marketplace's platform. 19 (5) 'Third-party seller' means any seller, independent of an online marketplace, that sells, 20 offers to sell, or contracts to sell a consumer product in this state through by utilizing an 21 online marketplace. The term 'third-party seller' does Such term shall not include, with 22 respect to an online marketplace: 23 (A) A seller that operates the online marketplace's platform; or 24 (B) A business entity that has: 25 (i) Made available to the general public the entity's name, business address, and 26 working contact information; (ii) An ongoing contractual relationship with the online marketplace to provide the 27 online marketplace with the manufacture, distribution, wholesaling, or fulfillment of 28 29 shipments of consumer products; and 30 (iii) Provided to the online marketplace the identity information required under 31 subsection (a) of Code Section 10-1-941 that has been verified in accordance with 32 subsection (d) of Code Section 10-1-941."

33 SECTION 3.

34 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
