EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN COBB AND FULTON COUNTIES
ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF**

WHEREAS: Officer Jeremy R. Labonte, 24, with the Roswell Police Department died in the line of duty on February 7, 2025; and

WHEREAS: Known for his dedication to public service, Officer Labonte began his career in law enforcement in 2021 with the Roswell Police Department; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Officer Labonte's service to the citizens of Roswell by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and in Cobb and Fulton Counties to half-staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF OFFICER JEREMY R. LABONTE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Cobb and Fulton counties on Wednesday, February 12, 2025, the day of Officer Labonte's interment, until sunset.
