## **EXECUTIVE ORDER**

## BY THE GOVERNOR:

## FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN COBB AND FULTON COUNTIES ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS: Officer Jeremy R. Labonte, 24, with the Roswell Police Department died in

the line of duty on February 7, 2025; and

WHEREAS: Known for his dedication to public service, Officer Laborate began his career

in law enforcement in 2021 with the Roswell Police Department; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Officer Laborate's service to the citizens

of Roswell by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and in Cobb

and Fulton Counties to half-staff.

Now, therefore, in honor of and as a mark of respect for the memory of Officer Jeremy R. Labonte, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the state of Georgia, it is

**Ordered:** That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Cobb and Fulton
