EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On November 14, 2024, Mrs. Audrey Gibbons, member of the Glynn County Board

of Education, was indicted by the United States Attorney for the District of

Delaware on one count of Conspiracy to Commit Money Laundering; and

WHEREAS: A certified copy of the indictment was transmitted to the Governor pursuant to

Code Section 45-5-6(b) and received on January 14, 2025; and

WHEREAS: Executive Order 01.29.25.02 was issued on January 29, 2025, appointing

members to the Review Commission to determine whether the indictment relates to and adversely affects the administration of the Glynn County Board of Education

such that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected; and

WHEREAS: Executive Order 02.12.25.01 was issued on February 12, 2025, extending the date

for the Review Commission to submit its report and recommendation; and

WHEREAS: On February 14, 2025, the Review Commission found that the indictment of Mrs.

Gibbons does relate to and does adversely affect the administration of the Glynn County Board of Education such that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected; and recommended that Mrs. Gibbons be suspended from office

pursuant to the provisions of Code Section 45-5-6.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Code Section 45-5-6, and the authority

VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED:

That Mrs. Audrey Gibbons is hereby suspended from office immediately and without further action pending the final disposition of the case or until expiration

of her term of office, whichever occurs first, as provided in Code Section 45-5-6(c).
