



# THE STATE OF GEORGIA

## EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 1.5 acres of improved real property (hereinafter the "Property") in Bulloch County, Georgia filed with the State Properties Commission Real Property Record as Property BLLIP ID# 003573; and
- WHEREAS:** Said Property is in the custody of the Georgia Forestry Commission and is commonly known as the Statesboro District Office; and
- WHEREAS:** The Property is improved with structures identified as the "District Office" (BLLIP #36030) (hereinafter, the "Structure"), as shown in the aerial photograph attached hereto as Exhibit A; and
- WHEREAS:** The Georgia Forestry Commission is desirous of demolishing the Structure due to damaged caused by Hurricane Helene; and
- WHEREAS:** By official action dated February 10, 2025, the Georgia Forestry Commission Board requested authority to demolish the Structure.

**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

- ORDERED:** The Georgia Forestry Commission is authorized and directed to provide for the razing, demolition, and disposal of said Structure under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interest of the State of Georgia, in accordance with applicable laws, policies, and procedures, including any requirements under O.C.G.A. § 12-3-55 regarding historic properties that may pertain to the Structure.
