EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 170.037 acres of improved real property (hereinafter the "Property") in Decatur County, Georgia filed with the State Properties Commission Real Property Record as Property BLLIP ID# 12155; and
- WHEREAS:** Said Property is in the custody of the Technical College System of Georgia and is commonly known as the Bainbridge Campus of Southern Regional Technical College; and
- WHEREAS:** The Property is improved with structures identified as the "Maple Center" (BLLIP #33226) (hereinafter, the "Structure"), as shown in the aerial photograph attached hereto as Exhibit A; and
- WHEREAS:** The Technical College System of Georgia is desirous of demolishing the Structure due to roof damage from Hurricane Michael; and
- WHEREAS:** By official action dated December 5, 2024, the Technical College System of Georgia Board requested authority to demolish the Structure.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT, TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

- ORDERED:** The Technical College System of Georgia is authorized and directed to provide for the razing, demolition, and disposal of said Structure under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interest of the State of Georgia, in accordance with applicable laws, policies, and procedures, including any requirements under O.C.G.A 12-3-55 regarding historic properties that may pertain to the Structure.
