EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 71.837 acres of improved real

property (hereinafter the "Property") in Murray County, Georgia filed with the State Properties Commission Real Property Record as Property BLLIP ID# 001022; and

WHEREAS: Said Property is in the custody of the Department of Natural Resources and is

commonly known as Fort Mountain State Park; and

WHEREAS: The Property is improved with a structure identified as the "Group Pavilion"

(BLLIP #24536) (hereinafter, the "Structure"), as shown in the aerial photograph

attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS: The Department of Natural Resources is desirous of demolishing the Structure due

to significant deficiencies that compromise safety, functionality, and compliance with

current standards; and

WHEREAS: By official action dated February 25, 2025, the Department of Natural Resources

Board requested authority to demolish the Structure.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

Ordered: The Department of Natural Resources is authorized and directed to provide for the

razing, demolition, and disposal of said Structure under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interest of the State of Georgia, in accordance with applicable laws, policies, and procedures, including any requirements under O.C.G.A.

§ 12-3-55 regarding historic properties that may pertain to the Structure.
