## EXECUTIVE ORDER

## BY THE GOVERNOR:

## FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN COLUMBIA COUNTY ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS: Deputy Brandon Ray Sikes, 31, with the Columbia County Sheriff's Office,

died in the line of duty on April 26, 2025; and

WHEREAS: With a heartfelt desire to make his community a safer place, Deputy Sikes

served with the Columbia County Sheriff's Office for more than six years;

and

WHEREAS: Prior to his service with the Columbia County Sheriff's Office, Deputy Sikes

honorably served in the United States Army as a combat medic; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Deputy Sikes' service to the citizens of

Columbia County by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and in

Columbia County to half-staff.

Now, therefore, in honor of and as a mark of respect for the memory of Deputy Brandon Ray Sikes, pursuant to the

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be

flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Columbia County on
