EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On May 28, 2025, Mr. Kelvin M. Owens, Mayor of Camilla, Georgia, was indicted on one count of Interference with Elections and two counts of Conspiracy to Commit Election Fraud; and

WHEREAS: A certified copy of the indictment was transmitted to the Governor pursuant to Code Section 45-5-6(b) and received on June 2, 2025; and

WHEREAS: The fourteen-day period following receipt of the indictment as prescribed by Code Section 45-5-6(e) has passed.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 45-5-6, AND THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That Attorney General Christopher Carr, Mayor Garnett Johnson of Augusta, Georgia, and Mayor LaRhonda Patrick of Warner Robins, Georgia are hereby appointed as the review commission to determine whether the above-mentioned indictment relates to and adversely affects the administration of duties by Mayor Owens such that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected thereby, and to make a written report to me within fourteen (14) days with a recommendation as to whether Mayor Owens should be suspended from office as required by Code Section 45-5-6(c).
