EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On May 28, 2025, Mr. Kelvin M. Owens, Mayor of Camilla, Georgia, was indicted on one count of Interference with Elections and two counts of Conspiracy to Commit Election Fraud; and

WHEREAS: A certified copy of the indictment was transmitted to the Governor pursuant to Code Section 45-5-6 (b) and received on June 2, 2025; and

WHEREAS: Executive Order 06.17.25.01 was issued on June 17, 2025, appointing members to the review commission to determine whether the indictment relates to and adversely affects the administration of duties by Mayor Owens such that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected; and

WHEREAS: Code Section 45-5-6(c) provides that additional time may be granted by the Governor for a review commission to make its written report; and

WHEREAS: On June 26, 2025, the above-mentioned review commission requested a fourteen-day extension to make its written report.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 45-5-6, AND THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the period for the above-mentioned review commission to make its written report is extended to July 15, 2025.
