EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 148.386 acres of improved real property (hereinafter the "Property") in Houston County, Georgia filed with the State Properties Commission Real Property Record as Property BLLIP ID# 09836; and
- WHEREAS:** Said Property is in the custody of the Department of Natural Resources and is commonly known as Flat Creek Public Fishing Area; and
- WHEREAS:** The Property is improved with structures identified as the "Judge Richardson Home" (BLLIP #30041), "J. Richardson Wellhouse" (BLLIP #30044), and "Storage Building" (BLLIP #30042) (hereinafter, the "Structures"), as shown in the aerial photograph and location map attached hereto as Exhibit A; and
- WHEREAS:** The Department of Natural Resources is desirous of demolishing the Structures due to significant deficiencies that compromise safety, functionality, and compliance with current standards; and
- WHEREAS:** By official action dated June 24, 2025, the Georgia Board of Natural Resources requested authority to demolish the Structures.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

- ORDERED:** The Department of Natural Resources is authorized and directed to provide for the razing, demolition, and disposal of said Structures under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interest of the State of Georgia, in accordance with applicable laws, policies, and procedures, including any requirements under Code Section 12-3-55 regarding historic properties that may pertain to the Structure.
