

## THE STATE OF GEORGIA

### EXECUTIVE ORDER

#### BY THE GOVERNOR:

- **WHEREAS:** There currently exist at Gordon State College, Lamar County, Barnesville, Georgia, a pool and surrounding structure known as the Aquatic Center (the "Structures") located at 419 College Drive; and
- **WHEREAS:** The Board of Regents' Policy 9.8.2.3 DEMOLITION authorizes the Chancellor or Vice Chancellor for Facilities to declare buildings, structures and other improvements no longer advantageously useful to the University System of Georgia. Said Structures are included within this policy; and
- **WHEREAS:** It has been determined by Ms. Sandra Lynn Neuse, Vice Chancellor for Real Estate and Facilities of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, that said Structures can no longer be advantageously used by Gordon State College or the University System of Georgia and should be removed.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BY THE POWER VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

**ORDERED:** That the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby authorized to demolish and remove the Structures from Gordon State College, Lamar County, Barnesville, Georgia.

#### IT IS HEREBY

**ORDERED:** That the appropriate staff of Gordon State College, acting under the approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, is hereby authorized to demolish the Structures and to have all Structure materials removed from the premises; all said demolition and removal to be performed as expeditiously as possible.
