EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On June 2, 2025, Mr. Theodore W. Hamby, III, Councilman on the Guyton City Council, was indicted on three counts of Financial Transaction Card Fraud and two counts of Making a False Statement; and

WHEREAS: The indictment was nolle prossed, and on June 4, 2025, Mr. Hamby elected to proceed under accusation for the same charges; and

WHEREAS: Certified copies of the indictment and accusation were transmitted to the Governor pursuant to Code Section 45-5-6(b) and received on June 23, 2025; and

WHEREAS: The fourteen-day period following receipt of the indictment and accusation as prescribed by Code Section 45-5-6(e) has passed.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 45-5-6, AND THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That Attorney General Christopher Carr, Dan Peterson of the Perry City Council, and Tommy Roberts of the Fitzgerald City Council are hereby appointed as the review commission to determine whether the above-mentioned charges relate to and adversely affect the administration of duties by Mr. Hamby such that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected thereby, and to make a written report to me within fourteen (14) days with a recommendation as to whether Mr. Hamby should be suspended from office as required by Code Section 45-5-6(c).
