EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On June 2, 2025, Mr. Theodore W. Hamby, III, Councilman on the Guyton City Council, was indicted on three counts of Financial Transaction Card Fraud and two counts of Making a False Statement; and

WHEREAS: The indictment was nolle prossed, and on June 4, 2025, Mr. Hamby elected to proceed under accusation for the same charges; and

WHEREAS: Certified copies of the indictment and accusation were transmitted to the Governor pursuant to Code Section 45-5-6(b) and received on June 23, 2025; and

WHEREAS: Executive Order 07.17.25.01 was issued on July 17, 2025, appointing members to the review commission to determine whether the indictment and accusation relate to and adversely affect the administration of duties by Mr. Hamby such that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected; and

WHEREAS: Code Section 45-5-6(c) provides that additional time may be granted by the Governor for a review commission to make its written report; and

WHEREAS: On July 22, 2025, the above-mentioned review commission requested a fourteen-day extension to make its written report.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 45-5-6, AND THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the period for the above-mentioned review commission to make its written report is extended to August 14, 2025.
