EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 320 acres of improved real property

(hereinafter the "Property") in Walker County, Georgia filed with the State Properties Commission Real Property Record as Property BLLIP ID# 003971; and

WHEREAS: Said Property is in the custody of the Department of Corrections and is commonly

known as Walker State Prison; and

WHEREAS: The Property is improved with a structure identified as the "Lawrence House"

(BLLIP #6960) (hereinafter, the "Structure"), as shown in the aerial photograph

attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS: The Department of Corrections is desirous of demolishing the Structure due to the

state of severe disrepair; and

WHEREAS: By official action dated April 3, 2025, the Georgia Board of Corrections requested

authority to demolish the Structure.

Now, therefore, pursuant to the authority vested in me as

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: The Department of Corrections is authorized and directed to provide for the razing,

demolition, and disposal of said Structure under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interest of the State of Georgia, in accordance with applicable laws, policies, and procedures, including any requirements under O.C.G.A. § 12-3-55

regarding historic properties that may pertain to the Structure.
