EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN DEKALB COUNTY ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS: Officer David Rose, 33, with the DeKalb County Police Department, died in

the line of duty on Friday, August 8, 2025; and

WHEREAS: With a heartfelt desire to serve, Officer Rose lived out his goals to protect

the vulnerable, stand for justice, and being the person who ran toward

danger. His life was the epitome of trust, duty, and sacrifice; and

WHEREAS: Prior to his service with the DeKalb County Police Department, Officer Rose

honorably served in the United States Marine Corps, including a

deployment in Afghanistan; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Officer Rose's service to the citizens of

DeKalb County by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and in

DeKalb County to half-staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF OFFICER DAVID ROSE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY

VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be

flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in DeKalb County on Friday, August 22, 2025, the day of Officer Rose's public memorial, until

sunset.
