

THE STATE OF GEORGIA

EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS:

There currently exists at Georgia State University, Fulton County, Atlanta, Georgia, a building known as Sparks Hall (the "Building") located at 33 Gilmer Street; and

WHEREAS:

The Board of Regents, at its meeting on January 14, 2025, declared that said Building could no longer be advantageously used by Georgia State University or the University System of Georgia and should be removed.

Now, therefore, by the power vested in me as Governor of the State of Georgia, it is hereby

ORDERED:

That the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby authorized to demolish and remove the Building from Georgia State University, Fulton County, Atlanta, Georgia.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED:

That the appropriate staff of Georgia State University, acting under the approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, is hereby authorized to demolish the Building and to have all building materials removed from the premises; all said demolition and removal to be performed as expeditiously as possible.
