
A PROCLAMATION


2025 GEORGIA NATIONAL FAIR

- WHEREAS:** The Georgia National Fairgrounds & Agricenter, through the annual Georgia National Fair, has long served as a proud showcase of our state's rich agricultural traditions, diverse cultures, and enduring community spirit. The Georgia National Fair is committed to promoting the values of citizenship, heritage, and civic pride that define the American experience; and
- WHEREAS:** In celebration of the nation's semi quincentennial, the Georgia National Fair proudly announces its participation in America250 — a national initiative to honor the past, celebrate the present, and inspire the future as we prepare for the 250th anniversary of American independence; and
- WHEREAS:** Through enhanced exhibits, patriotic displays, educational programming, and special commemorative events, the Georgia National Fair pledges to be the most spirited and patriotic state fair in the nation, bringing Georgians and visitors from all walks of life together in unity and pride; and
- WHEREAS:** Let it be known across the Peach State and beyond: the road to 250 passes through Perry, Georgia – and the Georgia National Fair is ready to lead the celebration.
