A PROCLAMATION

215TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE

INDEPENDENCE OF MEXICO

WHEREAS:

WHEREAS: Mexico has had a deep-rooted history with the State of Georgia since the establishment of diplomatic relations between Mexico and the United States of America on December 12, 1822; and 16th, 2025; and

Georgians join the Mexican and Mexican-American communities in celebrating Mexico's 215th anniversary of the proclamation of its independence on September

WHEREAS: Georgia is home to more than 570,000 Mexicans and Mexican-Americans who have enriched and contributed to the multifaceted fabric of our society while cultivating the collaborative relationship between the U.S. and Mexico; and

WHEREAS: since 1993; and Mexico and Georgia have shared official representation for several decades, with Mexico's consular presence in Atlanta since 1951 and Georgia's office in Mexico City

WHEREAS: In 2024, trade between Mexico and Georgia totaled close to \$25 billion, making Mexico one of Georgia's top trade partners; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim September 16, 2025, as the 215TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE INDEPENDENCE OF MEXICO in Georgia.

In witness thereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of the Executive Department to be affixed this $30^{\rm th}$ day of July in the year of our Lord, Two Thousand and Twenty-Five.
