WHEREAS: In the last state fiscal year, 1,169 children were adopted in the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS: Adoptive parents provide the opportunity for children and youth to experience the

stability, support, and unconditional love that every child needs to live, grow, and

thrive, preparing them for successful adulthood; and

WHEREAS: The Kemp Administration and Georgia General Assembly continue to prioritize

adoption and foster care reform, committing funds and passing legislation to decrease

the burden on adoptive parents and create new opportunities; and

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia and Department of Human Services are committed to educating

the public about the need for adoptive families, especially those with a desire to adopt

older children, children with complex needs, and sibling groups; and

WHEREAS: DHS celebrates the families who have opened their hearts and homes for children and

encourage Georgians to continue showing their commitment and support in making

a difference in children's lives through adoption; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

November 2025, as ADOPTION AWARENESS MONTH in Georgia.
