WHEREAS: It is important to raise awareness regarding this important aspect of workforce development to ensure that Georgia remains a state which is committed to personal and economic development; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim September 15-19, as ADULT EDUCATION AND FAMILY LITERACY WEEK in Georgia.
