WHEREAS: The State of Georgia is committed to the education and well-being of our children, and recognize the role quality afterschool programs play in preparing them to become successful adults and help our community thrive; and

WHEREAS: Lights On Afterschool, the national celebration of afterschool programs held this year on October 23, 2025, promotes the importance of quality afterschool programs for our children, families, and communities; and

WHEREAS: As the demand for afterschool programs continues to grow, many afterschool programs face operating challenges so severe that they are forced to consider closing their doors and turning off their light; and

WHEREAS: Georgia is committed to providing learning opportunities that help our children learn, grow, and develop the skills essential for success in life and work; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim October 23, 2025, as AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAM DAY in Georgia.
