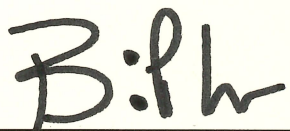
A PROCLAMATION

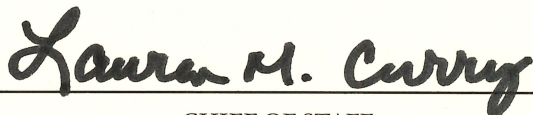
AIRLINE DISPATCHER DAY

- WHEREAS:** The United States Civil Air Regulations went into effect on November 1, 1937, establishing the Airline Dispatcher rating; and
- WHEREAS:** Airline dispatchers are entrusted with the safe movement of the traveling public, applying human expertise and critical judgment to plan optimal flight paths that balance safety, operational efficiency, and environmental sustainability; and
- WHEREAS:** In planning each flight, dispatchers carefully analyze aircraft performance and loading, enroute winds, hazardous weather, airspace restrictions, and airport conditions to select routes that minimize fuel consumption and environmental impact while prioritizing safety; and
- WHEREAS:** The operational control exercised by airline dispatchers through skilled human decision-making plays a critical role in aviation safety and ensures that aviation continues to be the safest mode of transportation; and
- WHEREAS:** Georgia is home to 944 certificated airline dispatchers, including over 500 employed by Georgias largest air carrier at the world’s busiest airport; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim November 1, 2025, as AIRLINE DISPATCHER DAY in Georgia.

In witness thereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of the Executive Department to be affixed this 14th day of October in the year of our Lord, Two Thousand and Twenty-Five.
