approximately 1 in 15,000 live births, characterized by developmental

delays, seizures, and lack of speech; and

85 individuals living with Angelman Syndrome reside in Georgia and

many family members who are affected by individuals living with

Angelman Syndrome; and

WHEREAS:

Increased public awareness can lead to earlier diagnosis, better care, and

improved support for families; and

WHEREAS:

The State of Georgia joins the Angelman Syndrome Foundation (ASF) in

observing Angelman Syndrome Awareness Day on February 15, 2025;
