A PROCLAMATION

BLOOD DONATION DAY

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia is committed to ensuring the safety and security of all those living

in and visiting the state; and

WHEREAS: A sufficient blood supply is a necessity both locally and nationally, and hospitals and

medical centers need a readily available supply for residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS: One blood donation can help save more than one life, and although most of the U.S.

population is eligible to donate blood, only about 3% do; and

WHEREAS: Georgia is home to many organizations committed to raising awareness about the

importance of blood donation, including the American Red Cross and others; and

WHEREAS: Georgia Blood Donation Day serves to remind us that we need to constantly replenish

our blood supply through donation and community awareness; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim September

4, 2025, as BLOOD DONATION DAY in Georgia.

In witness thereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of the Executive Department to be affixed this 28th day of March in the year of our Lord, Two Thousand and Twenty-Five.
