A PROCLAMATION

COMMUNITY BANKING MONTH

WHEREAS: For more than 150 years, Georgia community banks have been the backbone of local

economies, providing essential financial services that foster prosperity and growth. They have established a tradition of extensive community involvement; consistently reinvesting deposits into the communities they serve in the form of commercial,

agricultural, real estate, small business, and residential loans; and

WHEREAS: The Community Bankers Association of Georgia is celebrating its 57th year of serving

Georgia community banks; and

WHEREAS: Community banks are a driving force in local economic development, fostering

business growth, creating jobs, and strengthening the economic foundation of communities across Georgia. As major employers in Georgia, community banks provide thousands of jobs, serve millions of account holders, and contribute to the

financial well-being of their shareholders; and

WHEREAS: Approximately 135 independent community banks across Georgia continue to make

significant contributions to the well-being of Georgia communities with their financial

support and their dedication as good neighbors; and

WHEREAS: On average, approximately 95 percent of a community financial institution's loan

portfolio is reinvested in the local area as farm, commercial, residential, and small

business loans; and

WHEREAS: In order to create a greater public awareness and understanding of the important role

that community banks have played and will continue to play in our state, the State of Georgia will commemorate Community Banking Month during the month of April

2025; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim April

2025, as COMMUNITY BANKING MONTH in Georgia.
