A PROCLAMATION

CREDIT UNION DAY

- WHEREAS:** Credit unions have a long and distinguished history of promoting financial literacy, empowering communities, and fostering economic development by providing affordable financial services to their members across Georgia; and
- WHEREAS:** Credit unions are member-owned, not-for-profit financial cooperatives that prioritize people over profits, reinvesting earnings to benefit their members and support local communities; and
- WHEREAS:** The credit union industry in Georgia serves millions of residents, contributing significantly to the state's economy and providing critical access to financial resources in both rural and urban areas; and
- WHEREAS:** January 29th provides an opportunity to honor and celebrate the vital contributions of credit unions to the financial well-being of Georgia's citizens and to acknowledge their commitment to improving the quality of life for all Georgians; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim January 29, 2025, as CREDIT UNION DAY in Georgia.
