EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION APPRECIATION DAY

WHEREAS: The state of Georgia joins Georgia Child Care Association along with families,

communities, and organizations across the nation in celebrating the dedication and impact of early education providers, teachers, and caregivers who nurture and educate

Georgia's youngest learners; and

WHEREAS: Early childhood educators play a vital role in laying the foundation for lifelong

learning, helping children build critical cognitive, social, and emotional skills during

the most formative years of brain development—from birth to age five; and

WHEREAS: Access to high-quality early care and education is essential for working families,

supports children's mental and emotional well-being, and strengthens Georgia's workforce and economy by enabling parents to participate fully in the labor force; and

WHEREAS: The state of Georgia is proud to be home to nearly 3,200 licensed early childhood

programs, collectively serving more than 300,000 children across diverse communities;

and

WHEREAS: Early childhood educators are uniquely skilled in fostering early literacy, language

development, and school readiness—contributing to better educational outcomes and

stronger communities statewide; and

WHEREAS: The continued success and future prosperity of the State of Georgia are inextricably

linked to the quality of early childhood experiences provided today, and investing in

early educators is a direct investment in Georgia's future; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim May 10,

2025, as EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION APPRECIATION DAY in

Georgia.
