EDUCATOR MENTAL HEALTH
AWARENESS MONTH

- WHEREAS:** Georgia’s educators dedicate their time, energy, and expertise to preparing students for future success, often going above and beyond to meet the academic and emotional needs of their students; and
- WHEREAS:** The teaching profession demands significant emotional and mental investment, which, without proper support, can lead to stress, fatigue, and burnout; and
- WHEREAS:** Educator mental wellness directly impacts the quality of instruction, student outcomes, and the overall health of Georgia’s education system; and
- WHEREAS:** The month of November marks a critical point in the school year, when educators have carried their classrooms through the longest stretch of the semester, and need recognition, encouragement, and community support; and
- WHEREAS:** Highlighting the importance of educator mental health fosters understanding, reduces stigma, and ensures Georgia’s teachers are supported in sustaining long and fulfilling careers, and it is fitting and proper to designate time for all Georgians to recognize, support, and uplift the mental health of those who serve our students; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim November 2025, as EDUCATOR MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH in Georgia.
