
A PROCLAMATION


FLEET DAY

- WHEREAS:** The Fleet Management Division (FMD) of the Georgia Department of Administrative Services, under the direction of and in partnership with the Governor’s Office of Planning and Budget, as outlined in State Policy 10 Purchase and Use of Motor Vehicles, and its partners, provides cost-effective oversight of over 20,000 State of Georgia fleet vehicles, ensuring their efficient management from initial acquisition through disposal, thereby contributing to the states operational efficiency and public safety; and
- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia leads the way in managing fleet operations by leveraging cutting-edge technology, including telematics and advanced maintenance tracking systems, and data to enhance safety, reduce maintenance costs, and streamline operations for vehicle leasing and ownership, fuel, parts and service; and
- WHEREAS:** State fleet management leaders provide guidance grounded in industry best practices and adherence to state policies that ensure thousands of drivers of state vehicles have the tools and resources needed to navigate our roads with confidence. The safety of our roads and drivers is paramount, and ongoing FMD training programs for state vehicle operators play a crucial role in enhancing safety protocols; and
- WHEREAS:** Fleet Day is the annual gathering of state fleet leaders, managers, professionals, and contract suppliers dedicated to building a community of networking and experience in leading national and state practices, policies and techniques. Collaboration between various state agencies promotes inter-agency efficiency and helps disseminate best practices across the spectrum of government operations, reinforcing our commitment to excellence; and
- WHEREAS:** The observance of Fleet Day serves as an opportunity to honor the hard work, dedication, and professionalism of those who operate and maintain our state’s fleet, acknowledging their commitment to excellence and safety; now
