A PROCLAMATION

FOCAL SEGMENTAL GLOMERULOSCLEROSIS AWARENESS DAY

WHEREAS: Approximately 1 in 7 American adults have chronic kidney disease, and the third

leading cause of chronic kidney disease is glomerulonephritis, often caused by rare

kidney diseases such as focal segmental glomerulosclerosis (FSGS); and

WHEREAS: Focal segmental glomerulosclerosis is a condition referring to the scarring in the

kidneys, and it often leads to a difficult journey that can in many cases result in kidney failure, requiring dialysis, transplant, and often cycles of remissions and relapse; and

WHEREAS: FSGS is a severe disease that often progresses rapidly to kidney failure and even for

patients with primary FSGS who receive a kidney transplant, FSGS can recur in their transplanted kidney up to 50 percent of the time. 50 percent of patients with FSGS

require dialysis or a kidney transplant within 5-10 years of their diagnosis; and

WHEREAS: FSGS can be diagnosed at any age, but diagnoses are most prevalent in adults over 45

years old. Many patients face delays in diagnosis with FSGS, due both to the difficulty of the rare disease diagnostic odyssey and challenges in accessing specialty nephrology

care across the nation; and

WHEREAS: FSGS is a significant burden not just to the health and lives of patients and their

families, but also incurs great challenges for the healthcare system and healthcare

financing of Georgia; and

WHEREAS: There is new hope for patients with FSGS, with clinical trials underway for medicines

that may delay progression of FSGS and the onset of kidney disease, including the potential for FDA approved therapies soon, and significant progress being made by patients, families, advocacy organizations like NephCure, researchers, and industry to

validate proteinuria as an indicator of improvement in patients; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim June 10,

2025, as focal segmental glomerulosclerosis Day in Georgia.

In witness thereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of the Executive Department to be affixed this 29th day of April in the year of our Lord, Two Thousand and Twenty-Five.
