public safety, and promoting quality of life in Georgia; and

WHEREAS: More people encounter Municipal Court Clerks than all other court personnel

in Georgia and the public impression of the entire Georgia judicial system is largely dependent upon the public's experience with municipal courts; and

WHEREAS: Municipal Court Clerks have pledged to be ever mindful of their neutrality and

impartiality, rendering equal service to all, and conforming to the standards set by the Uniform Rules for Municipal Courts of the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS: It is most appropriate that we recognize the Municipal Court Clerks representing

nearly 400 Georgia Municipal Courts and the critical role they play; and

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia recognizes the positive impact Municipal Court Clerks

have had on its citizens and quality of life; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

June 9 – 13, 2025, as GEORGIA MUNICIPAL COURT CLERK WEEK in

Georgia.
