A PROCLAMATION

GEORGIA POISON PREVENTION WEEK

WHEREAS:

America's Poison Centers reports that each year, over two million people are

unintentionally poisoned in the United States; and

WHEREAS:

In 2024, the Georgia Poison Center handled over 73,000 human poison exposure calls,

of which, 38% involved children under the age of six and 30% involved adults ages 20

-59 years old; and

WHEREAS:

Despite the best efforts of poison center services, community organizations, and the

use of child-resistant safety packages, poisoning is still the leading cause of

unintentional injury-related deaths in the United States; and

WHEREAS:

It is vital for all citizens to be aware of the dangers of potentially poisonous substances

such as medications, household cleaning products, dietary supplements, vitamins,

pesticides, and bites and envenomation; and

WHEREAS:

In an effort to reduce the incidence and impact of poisoning in Georgia, all residents

are encouraged to learn about the valuable, lifesaving, and cost-effective resources

from the Poison Help line number, 1.800.222.1222, available 24 hours per day, 7 days

per week, and 365 days per year; now

THEREFORE:

I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim March

16-22, 2025, as GEORGIA POISON PREVENTION WEEK in Georgia.
